- ♦ 2010 Wednesday Night Race Application– You must be an SYC or PHYC member to be eligible to race. **SYC boats make cheque payable to Sarnia Yacht Club. PHYC fees are US Funds only.** (Note: mail to Dave Kember 836 London Rd, Sarnia ON N7T4Y2).
- ♦ Please visit and stay in touch with the latest news on 2010 MORC Racing at www.sarniayachtclub.on.ca and www.phyc.org. The 2010 Race Program will available on the SYC and PHYC websites.

Mark your calendars now with the following dates:

- ♦ **MORC Wednesday Night Race Application – late penalty applies after April 15th.**
- ♦ **Pay SYC by April 30th to avoid new PST charges.**
- ♦ May 26th – Wednesday Night Tune-Up, Skippers meeting after the race at SYC with free pizza.
- ♦ June 2 – Spring Series begins – all registrations must received with full payment to be eligible to race.
- ♦ **AGAIN FOR 2010** – Summer BBQ Series – June 26, July 24, August 21, September 25. Entry is free or all registered MORC boats and all SYC Members. Watch SYC website for more details.
- ♦ July 14th has been selected as the night when we wish to encourage all registered boats to offer a crewing opportunity to those learning to sail. Please let us know if you can assist.
- ♦ September 15th – First race of the Frost Bite series followed by free pizza and 2010 Overall Winners presentation.

Important messages:

- ♦ As always, please check the 2010 Race Program before the first race.
- ♦ Just a reminder - the following is an extract from the 2010 Race Program:
*Participants assigned Pizza Sales and Clean Up shall be responsible for the sale of pizza in or about the SYC bar area. Duties also include the collection and disposal of all empty pizza boxes and associated napkins etc. It is also required that those assigned to Pizza and Clean Up **will remain to assist in the general clean up of the bar area and/or clubhouse after the bar is declared closed.
