- Location:** Sarnia Yacht Club (Lake Huron)
- Date:** Youth Training Festival – Friday July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2007  
Championship and Gold Cup Regatta – Sat. and Sun., July 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>, 2007
- Organizing Authority:** Sarnia Yacht Club, Ontario Sailing and Canadian Yachting Association
- Accommodation:** Camping available on site. Campers under 18 must have an adult supervisor on site. Motels (car required) –contact Tourism Sarnia-Lambton, 1-800-265-0316 or web go to [www.tourism-sarnia-lambton.com](http://www.tourism-sarnia-lambton.com)
- Facilities:** Cash snack bar, pay phones, washrooms, fenced facility, walking distance to other restaurants and variety stores, marine hardware and sail loft
- Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- Advertising:** This is a category “C” event.
- Classes:** Byte, Laser, Laser>>, Laser Radial, 420(spin/trap) and 29er.  
**NOTE: At least five (5) boats must be registered for a class to have a start.**  
**Note: There will be a start for Byte CII if 5 or more boats are pre-registered by July 1st**
- Eligibility:** All competitors must be a member of a club that complies with RRS –75  
Competitors must comply with ISAF Eligibility Code. Non-Canadian competitors must show proof of membership in their own National Sailing Authority.
- Inspection & Measurement:** Boats may be inspected at any time during the regatta for compliance with class rules.
- Safety:** Life jackets must be worn at all times while afloat except while changing clothing. This changes the preamble to Part 4 and RRS -40. A 5 metre x 6 mm tow line must be attached to each boat’s mast. The mainsheet will *not* be considered a tow line.
- Pre-Registration:** All competitors are encouraged to pre-register via Ontario Sailing online regatta registration @ [www.sailon.org](http://www.sailon.org)

**Onsite-Registration:** Check-in at Sarnia Yacht Club office on arrival (see times below) to obtain participant packages. Extra fees for on-site registration.

**Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions provided at registration.

**Fees:** Youth Festival/Clinic - \$10/person (includes breakfast, and lunch, Friday)  
Championship Regatta - \$60/competitor and \$25/coach (includes Friday dinner, breakfast, lunch and dinner Saturday, and breakfast and lunch Sunday, and regatta T-shirt). GST will be added to all on-line registration fees. (On-site registration will be GST *included* –Clinic-\$10; Regatta-\$75; Coaches \$30)

**Youth Training Festival:** Friday, July 6<sup>th</sup>, starting at 10 am  
Ontario Sailing/CYA coaches and guest coaches will provide on water and dry land training sessions for participants, on water lunch, evening wind-up with dinner

**Racing:** A maximum of 7 races are scheduled, 1 or more completed races constitutes a series. One race will be dropped after 5 races are completed.  
1<sup>st</sup> race warning - 10:00 am, Saturday July 7<sup>th</sup>  
1<sup>st</sup> race warning - 10:00 am, Sunday July 8<sup>th</sup>  
**NOTE:** There will not be a competitors' meeting prior to the start of racing. Administrative announcements will be posted on the Official Notice Board

**Scoring:** Low point scoring System (RRS Appendix A)

**Prizes:** CYA Championship, Ontario Sailing Championship, & Sailfest Sarnia 2007 (SYC) Awards

**Special Note:** **The CYA Youth Code of Conduct shall be in effect for all competitors at the regatta and all participants shall sign a copy of the CYA Youth Code of Conduct at registration. SAILFEST SARNIA 2007 has a zero tolerance policy with regards to alcohol and drugs on club property.**

**Ontario Sailing Title Events Series Championship**

**Classes of Boats**

Byte, Byte CII, Radial, Laser, 420, 29er

**Age Groups**

16 and Under, 18 and Under, 23 and Under.

**Awards**

Top 3 in each fleet will receive awards at each regatta.

**Ontario Sailing Title Events Series Championship**

In addition to the awards for each regatta, awards will be given for the Ontario Sailing Title Events Series Championship.

First Regatta            Sailfest Sarnia            July 7 and 8

Second Regatta        PCYC Four Sisters            July 21 and 22

Third Regatta RHYC CYA National August 10 and 11

Fourth Regatta RHYC Cornish Hen            September 9 and 10

In order to qualify for the series championship, participants must sail in 3 out of the 4 regattas.

The low point scoring system shall be used to calculate the overall series championship scores. Each boat's overall series championship score shall be the total of her finishing positions in each of the four Title Events in the competitor's age group, excluding her worst score.

The winner in one age category will not be eligible to win a second category.

Series Awards will be presented at the Annual General Meeting of Ontario Sailing in January 2008.
